The tide tables in the NAMRIA website provide information on the time and heights of high and low waters which is vital to ensuring the safe passage of ships through shallow waters and narrow channels.

The local government units represent the 9.07% and the government-controlled corporations represent the 0.27%. The other respondents are from the non-government organizations at 1.10%.
